10. The institute will ensure the eligibility criteria of the students as per the NSDC Norms.

11. The funds to the extent are available under the scheme.

12. The stamped receipt for the amount sanctioned may be sent by return of post.

13. Utilization Certificate for the sanctioned amount to be submitted before release of 2nd installment.

14. If the Institution has charged any caution money, the same to be reported in the income & expenditure statement.

15. The Institute shall run training for each job role as prescribed by respective sector skill council.

16. Balance funds will be released as per the provision under the Guidelines of the Scheme

17. The institute found violating the above-described conditions, will not be given any grant by AICTE.

18. Interest on the sanctioned grant will be treated as part of the grant-in-aid and shall be used for the Project purpose only and the same shall be mentioned in the audited statement of accounts.

19. Project sanctioned by AICTE is assigned a specific Reference No. given on the pre-page. All correspondences related to the project must contain this number with year of sanction of the project failing which correspondence will not be entertained.

20. The Institute/Polytechnic shall not charge any overheads on this project and will provide all the administrative support for completion of the project.

21. The grantee shall utilize grants on only approved items of expenditure. However in case the grantee wishes to recast the project, approval of the Council must be obtained for the revised item of expenditure and they will maintain proper accounts of the expenditure as per the norms/procedures of AICTE/Government of India.

PFD Level 1 complete data flow





1 INTRODUCTION

4 FIELD SOIL INVESTIGATION PROCEDURE

The following methods were adopted for sub-soil investigations as per IS: 1892-1979. Two soil investigation bores of I5O mm diameter upto a depth of 10 meters were proposed and drilled within the proposed structure location. Boring was done using combination of shell and auger methods with casing pipe to depending upon the type of strata met with in the bore hole location using hand boring machine. Bore holes of I5O mm diameter with casing pipe were drilled to facilitate collection of Undisturbed and Disturbed soil samples and to conduct Standard Penetration Tests.

Standard Penetration Tests (SPT) were conducted at every meter interval within each bore. These tests were conducted as per IS: 2131-1981. Number of disturbed but representative soil samples were collected from the auger cuttings sand bailers for identification and for conducting laboratory tests. The bore holes were advanced up to a depth of 5.0 m below the existing ground level. A Stratum is considered to be hard, when the standard penetration test value, N i.e. the number of blows required for 300 mm penetration of the PT spoon beyond a seating penetration of 150 mm in the strata is more than SO Clause 3.3.3 of IS:3132-1981). If the penetration of the spoon is less than 300 mm for more than 50 blows, the N value is represented as N>50. The depth of water table at the end of boring is observed. All the results obtained from the field operations are shown in the log of bores.

5 LABORATORY TESTS

Index tests such as natural moisture content, liquid limit, plastic limit and unit weight were conducted on DS/UDS soil samples as per Indian Standard to identify and establish the consistency of these soils. Sieve analysis tests were also conducted on cohesionless soil for knowing the particle size distribution and classification of soil. Unconfined compressive strength tests and direct shear tests were conducted on UD soil samples to know the shear strength of soil. The results are given in Table 1. The idealized design soil parameters are given in Table 2.

6 SUB SOIL PROFILE

The Sub soil profile at the bore hole locations, based on the identification of soil samples and the results of tests (both field and laboratory) are indicated below.

7 SELECTION OF FOUNDATION AND BEARING CAPACITY OF SOIL

The proposed structure is a RCC framed structure supported on beams and columns. Open foundation in the form of footings and/or raft is most suitable.

The size and depth of foundation can be decided based on loading and soil characteristics. Based on the soil profile, it is advisable to place the foundation at a depth of 2.50 meters below the existing ground level.

The allowable bearing capacity of soil is calculated as per IS 6403 using the following equation:

The bearing capacity factors, shape factors, depth factors and inclination factors are obtained from IS:6403 based on the shear parameters.

An allowable bearing capacity of 350 KN/m2 is recommended at the above foundation depth for open foundation. Below the base of the foundation, 75mm thick sand bed and 100 mm thick bed concrete is proposed.

Description:

This Work focused on developing a system to accurately detect and classify different types of skin cancer. The primary goal was to assist medical professionals in early diagnosis by automating the process.

Key steps involved in the research:


- 1. Image Acquisition: A dataset of dermoscopic images was utilized for the study.
- Preprocessing: Images underwent preprocessing steps such as grayscale conversion, noise removal using Gaussian and median filters, and hair removal using the Dull Razor method.




Fig 1: Thermal energy storage tank with Solar water Reliedu Dist A.P 522 549




Fig 2: Model of Thermal energy storage tank system


