#### 8. General:

- Both the parties agree that it is a skill development initiative and placement of all the trained candidates is not a guaranteed outcome from this agreement
- This Agreement can be amended based on mutual agreement in writing by both the parties. The
  Program Partner upon signing this agreement will continue to provide the service without any
  change or alteration in the facilities as mentioned in this agreement.
- In the event any provision of this Agreement is found to be legally unenforceable, such unenforceability shall not prevent enforcement of any other provision of the Agreement.
- This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of India and applicable to agreements made and fully to be performed therein. This agreement is subject to Hyderabad Jurisdiction.
