



Outcomes:


Students became aware that, regardless of gender, they can pursue their goals and aspirations freely, leading to greater personal fulfilment and well-being.







Students became aware that, Education helps to reduce disparities between genders by addressing discriminatory practices and promoting equal access to resources and opportunities.




Finally, Sri. Dr N.R.M Reddy Garu was felicitated by the college dignitaries, and the program concluded with a vote of thanks.





The theme for International Women's Day 2023 is "DigitALL: Innovation and Technology for Gender Equality tomorrow".


